GENERAL CATALOG INFORMATION

The Ampex Stereo Tape Catalog shows all the open reel, 8track, cassette and quadraphonic tapes available thru the Ampex Shopper's Service. After each popular album title are several of the featured selections on that album. Classical titles are followed by featured soloists, orchestra, and conductor.

Prices and availability are subject to change without notice.

TAPE CODES

The following abbreviations are used to designate tape configuration.

(OR) Open Reel

(C) Cassette

(8T) 8-Track

PRICES

Following the album description are the catalog numbers and price code denoting manufacturer's suggested list price. Please note that albums are only available in the format indicated.

EXAMPLE:

GALLERY/NICE TO BE WITH YOU.

(C) SUS 57017M (8T) SUS 87017M

The example above indicates that this album is available through the Ampex Shopper's Service in the cassette and 8track configuration. The letter following the catalog number indicates manufacturer's suggested list price of \$6.95 on both configurations (see table below). GALLERY/NICE TO BE WITH YOU would not be available through the Shopper's Service on open reel tape.

TAPE TYPES AND SPEEDS

All Ampex Stereo Tape albums contained in this catalog are recorded on either one reel, cartridge, or cassette unless otherwise indicated. The words

"Doubleplay," or "Tripleplay," indicate how many LP records have been combined onto one album. "Two Reels," "Three Reels," etc., following the album selections indicates how many reels, cartridges, or cassettes are included in the tape box.

All open reel tapes have been recorded at 7½ ips except where denoted by an asterisk (*) preceding the catalog number.

EXAMPLE:

*(OR) TAM 302X

This designation would indicate an open reel tape recorded at 3¾ ips.

Open reel and cassette tapes employing the Dolby noise reduction system are indicated by catalog numbers in boldface type as shown in the following example.

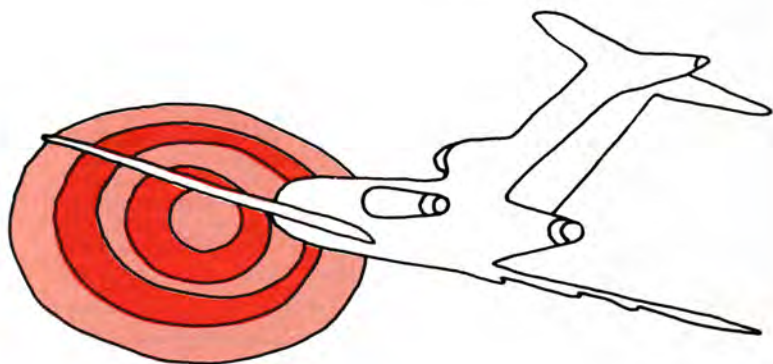
